RISD IHW Consent to Share Health Information

This Consent to Share Health Information applies to the care you receive at Rhode Island School of Design's (RISD) Integrated Health and Wellness (IHW) in the departments of Health Services and Counseling and Psychological Services (CAPS).

RISD IHW clinicians and providers engage in an integrated and holistic healthcare model. Your health information may be shared or viewed by the licensed health providers, clinicians, and staff employed by RISD IHW for the purpose of providing and recording your healthcare. Sharing of health information includes the content of your health record during the entirety of your time as a RISD student.

Accordingly, shared health information encompasses all information in your past and future health records including, but not limited to, assessments, diagnosis, treatments, medications, and/or details of your condition to support optimal treatment and care coordination. Clinicians at both clinics may consult with other providers to coordinate your care as appropriate. These discussions are specific and limited.

RISD IHW complies with any and all applicable federal and state laws and regulations and professional ethics related to the confidentiality of your health information, including the Family Education Rights and Privacy Act (FERPA) and the Rhode Island Confidentiality of Health Care Communications and Information Act (RIGL 5-37.3). In addition, the confidentiality of your health information is protected under the Notice of Privacy Practices and Patient Bill of Rights and Responsibilities which can be found on the RISD IHW Patient Portal.

This Consent to Share Health Information supersedes any previously signed consent regarding the sharing of health information with RISD IHW, Health Services, and/or CAPS. You may revoke this consent at any time, in writing, except to the extent your health information has already been shared in reliance upon this content. If you are under 18 years of age, you must also print the Authorization to Treat a Minor form from our website which must be signed by your parent/guardian and uploaded to the patient portal.
